

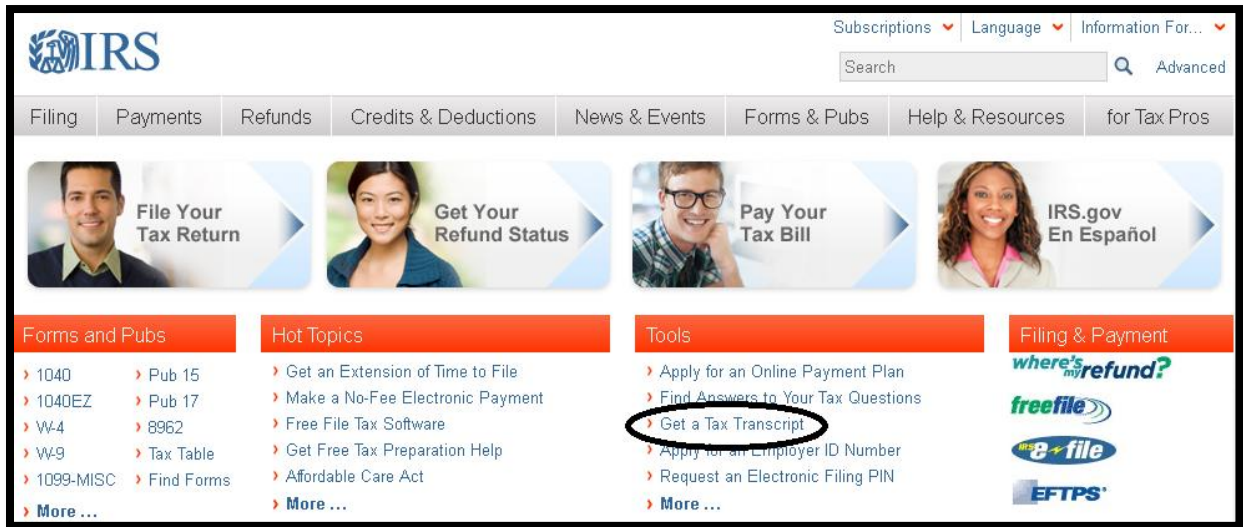


Tax filers can request Tax Return Transcripts free of charge.

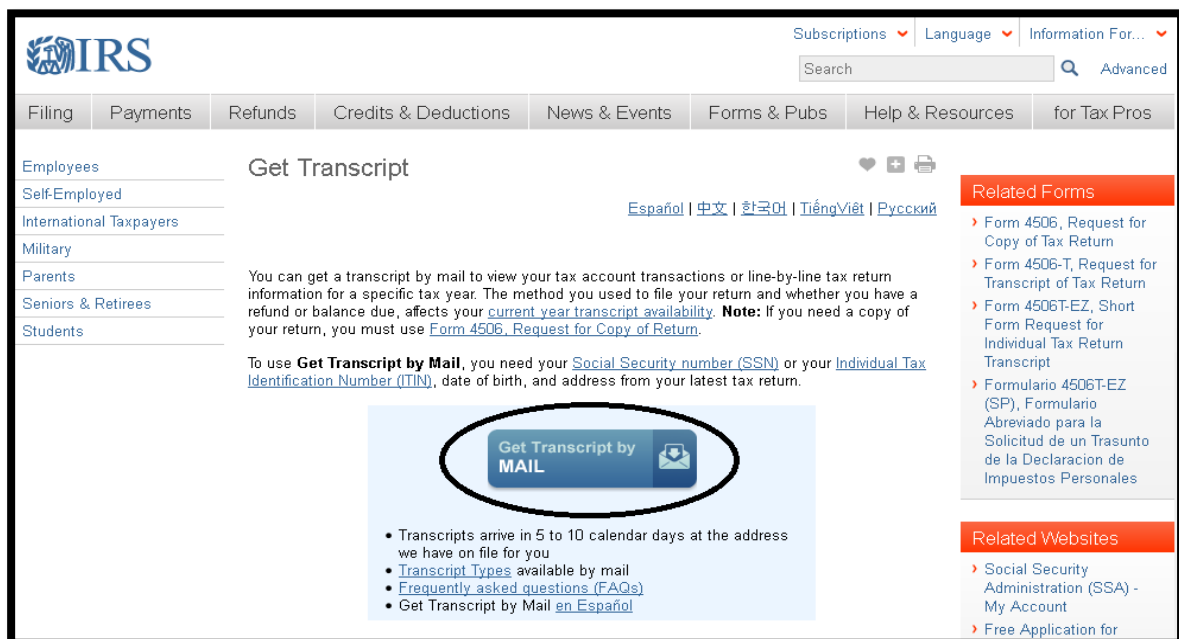
Method #1: Ordering transcripts online (by mail)

Step 1: Go to www.irs.gov

Step 2: Under the Tools tab, click on “Get a Tax Transcript”



Step 3: Select “Get Transcript Online”



Step 4: Fill out the required information to submit request, forms will be sent to mailing address provided to the IRS

Method #2 Telephone Request:

- Available from the IRS by calling **1-800-908-9946**
- Tax filers must follow prompts to enter their social security or TIN number used to file taxes, and the numbers in one's street address (generally the numbers of the street address that were listed on the latest filed tax forms). However, if an address change has been completed either through the IRS or the US POSTAL Service, the IRS may have the updated address on file.
 - For a joint tax return, use the primary tax filer's social security number, date of birth, street address, and zip or postal code.
- Select **“Option 2”** to request an IRS Tax Return Transcript and then select the appropriate Tax Filing Year.
- If successfully validated, tax filers can expect to receive a paper IRS Tax Return Transcript at the address included in one's telephone request within 5 to 10 business.
 - IRS Tax Return Transcripts requested by telephone cannot be mailed to a different address.
