ENGL 060 C College Writing Preparation 4 Units

Prerequisite: Acceptable score on placement test, ENGL 058 C with a grade of "C" or better, or ESL 186 C with a grade of "C" or better.

Term hours: 72 lecture English 60 is designed to prepare students for success in English 100. The focus of this course is reading, critical analysis, and writing expository essays. The fundamentals of grammar, sentence structure, and paragraph development are also reviewed. Non Degree Credit. Pass/No Pass/Letter Grade Option.

English 100 C College Writing

Prerequisite: Acceptable score on placement test or ENGL 060 C with a grade of "C" or better, or ESL 186 C with a grade of "C" or better

English 100 is a college level, transfer course in written communication. It is designed to develop reading, critical thinking, writing strategies necessary for academic success. The emphasis is on writing expository essays. Research and documentation skills will also be developed. Classes may have in-class tutors who can meet with students out-of-class. English 010LC

This 1/2 unit lab companion course to English 100 meets 1.5 hours a week. Its focus is developing reading and writing skills needed for success in English 100. Success is based on attendance and satisfactory completion of assignments.
